IX. OTHER ITEMS

D.7.1 Taking Membership of IIT Academy

IIT Academy is a category established by Govt of Kerala, India, IIT and IITs under 17P scheme. They are established under the Development and Welfare of Engineering, Computer for Kerala, Govt of Kerala, and Kerala University, TQIF College to receive the financial support by issuing an MoU with the period of five years.

Decision: BoC permitted to take membership in IIT Academy.

D.7.2 Remedial Classes in Engineering, Graphics & Engineering Mechanics

Some Engineering Graphics and Engineering Mechanics were identified as the subjects having the low number of failures in the first year exams. There were some students who had failed in these subjects. Remedial classes are to be arranged for students who are weak in the subjects. In consultation, HOD NB is providing remedial evening classes for a large number of first-year students who are not doing English and equipping them to appear for the remedial class with confidence.

Decision: HODs appreciated the efforts of Mr. Subrahman. The lectures regarding remedial classes are to be represented by an external expert for the failed subjects. Hence, a 1-2 week's remedial remedial evening needs to be given to the students who performed poorly in the subjects. HODs and the Principal should meet the poor performers to understand their problems and ensure them of the necessary help by the institution for it. Good Value Education such as NPTEL, Coursera etc, shall be shown to these students.

D.7.3 Coverage of subject

Decision: Every three months, there should be a review of the subject systems. HODs should meet the Principal with the details with special focus on the subjects where there are many failures. If needed, special remedial classes should be arranged with participation of all, including Principal, HODs, Faculty members, parents and student representatives. This is specially applicable for subjects which are found tough by first year students.

D.7.4 Website

Decision: College website shall be significantly improved in content and appearance, employ a professional team if necessary. Profiles of the HoG Chairman and members shall be prominently displayed. Dr. H.S. Manoj shall lead advisors in this regard.

D.7.5 Minutes of HoG

Decision: HoG decisions shall be retained and signed by the HoG members. The minutes shall be sent to all the members without fail.

D.7.6 High Intensity Training Programs

Decision: High intensity training programs have to be conducted for improving the employability of graduates for the 2015 post-grad level institute.

D.7.7 Low profile nature of Programs

Decision: The HoG noted that most of the programs are low profile. Future programs shall be oriented to high profile ones.

D.7.8 Research in the Campus

Decision: The proposed research guidelines of KUV, permits an institution to offer research programs leading to Ph.D. or other PG programs for a limit of six years and there are faculty members with Ph.D. in the relevant disciplines. The faculty members were advised to make use of this facility with YECOP assistance.

D.7.9 Suggestions by Dr. S.K. Dargu, Exg. Member

Dr. KR Dargu suggested the following with regard to the current legal status

1. Water shortage in the campus should be immediately addressed.
2. Backup power supply to essential departments should be provided.
3. Classification of the courses including skills should be maintained, if necessary by employing outside agencies.
4. Quality of the food provided in the canteen should be monitored and improved.
5. There should be plan to reduce the campus electricity bill by conservation. Various steps are suggested.
6. Seminar and library should be provided to the faculty members by organizing meet-works.
7. Transportation should be arranged if necessary by providing or two vehicles under YECOP.
8. Faculty members shall submit performance review of students regularly to the Director.
