The session started with a silent prayer and a self introduction of all present at the venue. The chairman stressed the importance of bringing faculty from premier institutions, and making it a long term goal to raise the institution to commendable standards. He urged the faculty to visit institutions of national importance in order to get exposure to the environment existing there. He appreciated Sri. Vipin Vasu for his hard work in preparing the procurement packages in time.

The chairman urged to prepare and supply agenda notes to all members well ahead of the meeting. He also urged to make it a point to deal with matters in a more professional way.

Most of the members, Mentor and the SPFU director expressed their displeasure in missing agenda notes for the meeting.

The Mentor had the opinion that the absence of Govt representatives should be taken note of seriously. Invitation to all members should be sent well in advance (in hardcopy) and not by email only.

The SPFU Director opined that the presence of the Government representatives would have the advantage of bringing issues, if any, to the notice of the Government for timely intervention to solve them. So he urged to ensure their presence in future meetings of the BoG.

Then, the Principal made a power point presentation about the progress of TEQTP activities achieved so far.

Subsequently, the Agenda items were considered for elaborate discussion and decisions were taken. The TEQIP coordinator read out the agenda items one by one. As he read out the items intervention of the nodal officers were sought for clarifications. The members deliberated on the points to arrive at appropriate decisions.

The agenda items and decision taken are listed in the following paragraphs.

BG 2.1 Ratification of the FDPs Conducted (In-house and External)

The Details of FDPs conducted were presented by the TEQIP Coordinator Prof. Showkathali V, which were ratified as such without any changes.

BG 2.2 Ratification of expenses met from IOC

The expenditure statement of items whose expenses were met from IOC was presented by the TEQIP coordinator. After going through the statement it was ratified. The SPFU Director Dr. Gopakumar V reiterated that it was not necessary to get ratification of BoG if the expenses come under the permissible category of PIP (IEQIP II).

BG 2.3 Approval of FSD programs planned for the coming months

The TEQIP coordinator read out the list of ESD programs planned for the next six months by incurring an estimated expenditure of Rs 45 lokhs. The chairman hinted that the estimated amount is insufficient for conducting 17 in-house programs by including faculty form premier institutions. The BoG accorded approval for the list without any change suggested. The Chairman suggested that more details about the in-house program (including a committee with a convener for each program, the duration and the period of the program, resource persons at least for some programs, approximate number of participants for each program, etc.) should be submitted to him within a manth. These details should be available to BoG members as well before the next BoG meeting.

BG 2.4 Approval of remedial classes planned for CSE, ECE & IT students

The committee approved the proposal to conduct remedial coaching classes for CSE, ECE and IT students of all semesters. The SPFU director made it clear that remedial coaching is given with a view to increase transition rate and pass percentage of students, and for the same reason the needy students of ongoing semesters should also be included. He reiterated that the modality was to give extended hours of coaching in subjects if found necessary under EAP by including students of ongoing semesters and failed candidates as well. So he advised to include the result awaiting ME branch also in remedial coaching classes,

BG 2.5 Approval of Bridge classes for all branches

BG 2.6 Approval for hiring bus services for about ten months for transporting students during holidays for attending remedial classes by incurring an approximate expenditure of Rs. 40000/- maximum per month. Permission is sought for meeting it from IOC.
