As per National Education Policy 2020, Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is a national-level facility to promote flexibility of curriculum framework and provide academic mobility of students with appropriate credit transfer mechanism to choose their own learning path to attain a Degree/Diploma/PG-diploma, etc, working on the principle of multiple entry-multiple exit as well as any-time, any-where, and any-level of learning.

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) will digitally store the academic credits earned by students from Higher Educational Institutions facilitating students to choose their own learning path to attain degree/Diploma/Certificates, working on the principle of multiple entry-multiple exits as well as any-time, any-where, and any-level of learning. The ABC platform has been developed by the National e-Governance Division (NeGD) of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) under the DigiLocker framework.

2. The realization and effectiveness of ABC depend upon how quickly all Higher Educational Institutions register with it and students create their ABC IDs. Approximately 600 academic institutions including various Universities, Central Higher Educational Institutions, Autonomous Colleges, etc. are registered with ABC and many students have created their ABC account for credit accumulation, recognition, redemption and transfer.

3. Considering the admission process for the ongoing academic session and the significance of this important Digital initiative in the education sector, Higher Educational Institutions are requested to capture the ABC IDs of the students during the admission process, so that at the time of academic credit data uploading, credits can be accumulated in their respective ABC account.

4. I, therefore, request your personal intervention to ensure that your academic institution comes on board with ABC and uploads academic data with students' earned credit obtained during or after the academic year 2021-2022 along with students' ABC ID at the earliest.
