

Attention to all candidates and affiliated student organisations

Throughout the election period, candidates are permitted to conduct processions and/or public meetings, subject to the condition that such activities shall not disrupt regular classes or any academic and co-curricular activities within the college premises. However, conducting any such procession or public meeting shall require prior written approval from the College Authority / Returning Officer.

In order to facilitate candidates in presenting themselves to the electorate, a certain level of flexibility is provided. Candidates may campaign within classrooms provided that there is no interference with the ongoing classes. The duration of campaigning within a classroom shall be strictly limited to a maximum of 15 minutes.

Prior consent from the concerned Head of the Department or the respective class teacher is mandatory before initiating any campaign activity within a classroom.

All candidates and affiliated student organisations are hereby instructed to strictly comply with the above directions. Any violation of these instructions will be viewed seriously and may invite appropriate action.
