CIRCULAR

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR B.Tech. CENTRALIZED SPOT ADMISSION ON 13 AUGUST 2026

As per the directions of the Government, **B.Tech Centralized Spot Admission 2026** will be conducted on **13 August 2026** for admission to the **9 Government Engineering Colleges and 3 Government-Aided Engineering Colleges (TKM, MACE and NSS CE)**.

Students participating in the Centralized Spot Admission are required to strictly follow the guidelines given below:

1. **Venue:** Students can participate in the Centralized Spot Admission by visiting **any one of the 9 Government Engineering Colleges or 3 Aided Engineering Colleges**.
2. **TC/NOC for already admitted students:** Students who are currently admitted to Private Self-finance Engineering Colleges in Kerala shall produce the **No Objection Certificate (NOC)/Transfer Certificate (TC)** from their present college for attending the Spot Admission.
3. **Fresh candidates:** Candidates seeking admission for the **first time** shall produce all the necessary documents mentioned in the KEAM 2026 prospectus for verification.
4. **Fee payment:** Students selected for admission through the Centralized Spot Admission shall pay the **prescribed fee as per Government norms**, while taking admission in the college on or before 14 August 2026, even if they have already paid fee while taking admission through an earlier allotment. For fee details, visit the website of the institution where the student is getting admission.
5. **Registration before 12 noon:** The student or his/her authorized proxy shall reach **any one of the above 12 colleges mentioned above before 12 noon on 13 August 2026** for registration. **In the case of a proxy, the necessary documents prescribed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE)** shall be produced.

Registrations will be closed at 12 noon sharp for the Centralized Spot Admission.

6. **Waiting at the registered college:** After registration/data entry, the student shall **remain at the registered college until the Spot Admission result is announced**.
7. **Allotment to a college other than the registered college:** If a student is allotted a seat in an Engineering College **other than the college where he/she has registered for centralized spot admission**, the student shall **complete the admission process in the allotted College on or before 4:00 PM on 14 August 2026, as 14th August 2026 is the last date for admission as per AICTE norms. TC date should be on or before 14th August 2026**.
8. **Documents for admission:** Students who are selected shall produce **all necessary original documents required for admission and verification** at the time of taking admission.

9. **Instructions of the registered college:** Students shall strictly follow **all instructions, procedures and directions issued by the respective college where they have registered for the Centralized Spot Admission.**
10. **Vacancy position and college-specific instructions:** Students are advised to visit the **official website of the college in which they are interested** to check the **category-wise vacancy position** and any additional instructions, procedures or rules applicable to the Spot Admission.
11. **Centralized spot admission will also be conducted to the vacant seats in Government Engineering Colleges where spot allotment was conducted on 11th August 2026. Waiting list, if any, prepared/published in these Engineering Colleges will be invalid based on the direction of the Government to conduct a Centralized spot admission.**

Important Note: 1) Once option registration is submitted, it cannot be changed later. Students are directed to verify options before final submission.

Important Note: 2) If allotment is received through Centralised spot admission process, the existing admission in Government and Government Aided Engineering Colleges will be cancelled and they must compulsorily take admission in the newly allotted college
